Since my introduction to your product, PermaGuard Fossil Shell Flour, approximately 10 years ago, I have fed this product to my saddle horses, 2 ounces, mixed with their grain twice a day.

This product has eliminated the need to worm my horses since feeding this product. Their coats are slick and shiny and they are full of energy and look excellent.

When I notice my two dogs rubbing their behinds on the ground I sprinkle a teaspoon of fossil shell flour on their food and within a couple of days they pass worms which eliminates their problem.

I personally have sprinkled some fossil shell flour on my breakfast cereal to clear up diarrhea in a couple of days.

We also sprinkle our tomato plants with fossil shell flour which keeps the plants free of the tomato worm and insects.

This is an all around product for these and other uses so we keep this product on hand at all times.

It took about a week for the horses to adjust to this product now they lick their bunks clean every time.
